

① "engrave, imprint, impress; write; define in form" **OUTLINE EVIDENCE** ② Mad Eye's glasses = indiv. identity

① - cause feelings of stigma (social isolation)  
 - VK kids wanted glasses now; undesirable → desirable \* More to go  
 - Animagus still have markings → Italian cover missing \* More to go  
 ↳ Polyjuice Potters all wear spare glasses ↳ on adult covers besides adult covers

① Snatchers looking for glasses → violent reunion → assures complete control  
 - Feels glasses when returning to body → "cutting into" identification  
 → glasses = physical pain & social isolation  
 ↳ define him  
 ↳ glasses wear Harry "other than Harry wearing the glasses" partial vision of truth/state

① Defined by glasses ("into")  
 - Don't protect you (as decided/written by JKR) → weakness  
 - Lense-less glass → what makes Harry Harry for Raddiffe  
 - Children find them unattractive  
 ↳ Dependancy → Knockturn Alley  
 ↳ Erised; Brazilian; Basilisk  
 ↳ Defined by them as tied

③ "to attribute character to"  
 ③ - Rowling wanted a hero who wore glasses  
 - "I didn't know you could read" to Gryll  
 - Ppl w/ glasses are faster/smarter \* Now desirable  
 - thought to look more intelligent/honest (better @ sports) → Quidditch (Dad combo)  
 ↳ Archetypal characters (wise old man) to disillusion Harry behind glasses  
 ↳ feels like everyone else w/ them off

③ - Harry "couldn't help it" → always wants to look  
 - Has sight that other characters lack (of plots at Hogwarts)  
 - Doesn't actually always use glasses on covers (1<sup>st</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup>)  
 ↳ glasses alone identify \* More to go  
 ↳ vulnerable (controlled by Voldemort)  
 ↳ nape/GOF cover  
 ↳ Mashif need in King's Cross

② "to describe/delineate peculiar qualities of"  
 ② - Harry as eyes of the book / Harry's pov  
 - clue to vulnerability  
 - Everyman → bring balance to character  
 - Glasses = parents → can't be changed/hidden (but slightly obscure)  
 ↳ Oculus Reparo in movies

② - He finally feels "like everyone else" when he takes them off  
 - Holds to eyes in Knockturn Alley → dependent  
 - Blind w/ basilisk → necessity of glasses  
 - Doesn't need them in Heaven/King's Cross Station (Dumb. still wears)  
 ↳ Reparo in movies  
 ↳ not using any magical  
 ↳ DH cover (still wearing green shirt)

③ ~~Snape's~~ Snape's dying wish  
 - Taped on GOF cover (only cover where surrounded by others)  
 - Sees but doesn't see ("strange how nearsighted" quote)  
 ↳ Independence  
 ↳ Glasses not mentioned at all in Epilogue → none of kids inherit  
 ↳ check out P ch. 28 & SS ch. 17 (photo album)

**Conclusion**  
 ③ Conclusion -  
 - Glasses = growing up → Independance v. Individual Identity  
 - In "reality" of books cannot get rid off; good & bad, but can overcome  
 ↳ must embrace differences; in weakness into strength; and never lose awareness  
 ↳ Results in Independance
